 being the residue and remainder of the black land I live on also a mare & Colt
 & a spanaw one felding later one bed & furniture to him & his heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath to my Son Benjamin Ten Pounds Virginia money one iron pot to
 him and his heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Phoebe a Bed & furniture & two ewes & lambs
 to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Winifred a Bed & furniture & one ewe &
 land & her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth a bed & furniture one ewe
 & lamb & one feld wheel to her and her heirs forever

Item I reserve all the residue & remainder of my estate to be equally divided
 between John & Henry & my three Daughters Except one Cabinet to my son
 John to the discretion of my executors hereafter mentioned to them & their heirs forever.

Item I do make ordain constitute & appoint my Sons John & Henry my whole
 & sole executors of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand & affixed my Seal this day and year first above written
