

Item my will & devise is that if my Son John Johnson die without heir in that Case I give all the land & personal Estate which I have given to my Son John Johnson to my Son Giles Johnson after my wife's Death the same to him & his heirs forever

Item my will & devise is that if my Son Giles Soyner dies without heirs in that Case I give all the land that I have given to my Son Giles Johnson to my Son John Johnson & to his heirs forever after my wife's Death
 And in Case both my Sons, to say my Son Giles Johnson and my Son John Johnson both die without heir in that Case I give all the land which I have given to my two Sons Giles Johnson & John Johnson to my Son Simon Johnson and to his heirs forever after my wife's Death

Lastly I do hereby make constitute ordain & appoint my loving wife Mary Johnson & my Son Giles Johnson my whole & Sole Executors of this my last will & testament Revoking & disannulling all other wills by me heretofore made or declared In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Seventeenth day of May 1777

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As a Court held for the County of Southampton the 1st day of February 1779 This will was ~~read~~ proved in Court by the oaths of Henry Pope Hardy Pope the witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded. And on the motion of John Johnson the executor therein named being refused ^{to justify} who made oath according to law qualification is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate Samuel Johnson with the will annexed giving Security whereupon &c

 John Britt's Will
 John Britt Son of Southampton County being of Sound and disposing mind & memory do make & ordain this my last will and testament in manner And form following first & foremost I recommend my Soul to Almighty God that gave it ~~and~~ my Body to be Decently buried and as for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I dispose of as follows
 In Premis Item I give to my Son Benjamin Britt Forty pounds it being the Sum due me from him for a mare & the him Item I leave all my land to be sold and the money equally divided amongst my five Sons Viz John Britt Jesse Britt Henry Britt James Britt and William Britt to them & their heirs forever but in Case either of them die without lawful Issue I devise the money to be Divided amongst them that is Surviving
 Item I give to my Son William Britt One Bay Colt & feather Bed & furniture but in Case he should die without Issue I devise they shall be divided among my five Sons mentioned Item I give to my wife Marthat Britt One feather bed & furniture one Cow & half One Sow & faggots Two Ewes one pot one dish & four plates & lend my said wife the use of my Negro woman Rose as long as she lives or widows but after her marriage or death I leave the said Negro Rose
