 County of Southampton being of Sound and disposing mind and memory, do make
 and ordain this writing as my last will and testament,

First I give and devise to my loving wife Ann Richs the plantation whereon I now
 live and reside with all the lands adjoining thereto which are contained in a Survey
 or plott left by me in the hands of my executors supposed by me to contain four hundred
 and eighteen acres and divided in the said plott by 25th 3 I also give and devise
 to my said wife Ann one other parcel of land adjoining the above supposed by me
 to contain one hundred and twenty and five acres being one moiety or half part
 of two hundred and fifty acres divided in the said plott by 1 and divided
 from a mulberry tree in the old field by Richard Richs line) and a li
 has a pious, also one large Coffee Kettle all my piggheads and
 Kettle cups and worms for and during the term of her natural life
