Robin Jones, Ned Moses Beck Eddy & her children Deborah Esther & Jones and their increase also one Bell metal Kettle one horse called Little Bay, four Cows and Calves one mare called Flower & her colt two small Sheep ten Head of Sheep, four Sows and pigs the two best feather Beds and furniture that are in the house one large Black bunk & two gilt bunks. Also one moiety or half part of my household and Kitchen furniture and plantation implements in such articles thereof as she shall choose according to the appraised value thereof likewise meat corn & salt sufficient for the support of her & her family the ensuing seasons to her and her heirs and assigns forever it is my will that the devices and bequests in this my will to my wife be considered in law and satisfaction of any deeper she may claim to any part of my estate real or personal. Also I give devise and bequeath to my nephew Richard Ricks One tract or parcel of Land containing three hundred acres granted to me by patent bounded and described in the aforesaid plott and denoted by no. also after the death of my wife I give to my said nephew Richard Ricks the plantation and lands whereon I now live supposed to contain four hundred & eighty acres and denoted in the plott aforesaid N<sup>o</sup> 3 Likewise one moiety or half part of one other tract or parcel of land containing one hundred <sup>and</sup> ~~and~~ acres bounded in the plott or Survey aforesaid and denoted therin N<sup>o</sup> 1 being the same herein devised to my wife during life together with all the things I have already professed him with to him and to his heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and to my nephew Joseph Ricks one tract or parcel of land containing one hundred twenty and five acres being the other moiety or half part of the two hundred and fifty acres herein particularly described and bound in the survey or plott aforesaid and denoted therin N<sup>o</sup> 7 also the sum of three hundred pounds current money to him and to his heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and devise to Samuel Ricks son of my nephew Thomas Ricks one tract or parcel of land supposed to contain four hundred seventy & five acres and bounded as described in the aforesaid plott and denoted therin by N<sup>o</sup> 3 to him and to his heirs & assigns forever. Also I give to Robert Ricks and John Ricks sons of my Nephew Thomas Ricks the sum of hundred pounds current money to equally divide between them or their heirs. Also I give and devise to my to my nephews Thomas Ricks Robert Ricks Richard Ricks and Joseph Ricks my fishing place on Notaway river in Lancaster county with the lands adjoining all the privileges thereto annex purchased by one of Richard Williams to hold to my said nephews Thomas Robert Richard & Joseph Ricks and to the survivors of them their heirs & assigns forever. Also I give and devise to my nephews Robert Ricks & Richard Ricks after the death of my wife my spilt pot cap and worm to hold to my said nephews Robert Ricks & Richard Ricks and to the survivor or survivors of them their heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and devise to my niece Ann Jones one Negroe Girl Hannah to her and to her heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and bequeath to my niece Mary Ricks after the death of my wife one large copper Kettle to her and her heirs. Also I give and bequeath to my nephews Robert Ricks and Richard Ricks after the death of my wife all my hogheads and Barrels to be equally divided between them also It is my will and desire that the household lands and the interest and tennants to come in the lands leased by me of the trustees of the Notaway Indians continue and
