Ned Moses Beck Edy & her children Pudence Esther & Jane and their increase also one bell metal Kettle one horse called little bay four cows and calves one mare called flower & her colt two small steers four head of sheep four sows and piggs the two best feather beds and furniture that are in the house one large Black trunk & two gilt trunks also one moiety or half part of my household and kitchen furniture and plantation implements in such articles thereof as she shall choose according to the appraised value thereof likewise meat corn & salt sufficient for the support of her & her family the ensuing seasons to her and her heirs and assigns forever it is my will that the devise and bequest in this my will to my wife be considered in lieu and satisfaction of any deeper the may claim to any part of my estate real or personal. Also I give devise and bequeath to my Nephew Richard Richs one tract or parcel of land containing three hundred acres granted to me by patent bounded and described in the aforesaid plat and denoted by N^o 5. also after the death of my wife I give to my said nephew Richard Richs the plantation and lands whereon I now live supposed to contain four hundred & eighteen acres and denoted in the plat aforesaid N^o 3 likewise one moiety or half part of one other tract or parcel of land containing ^{four hundred} ~~one hundred~~ acres bounded in the plat or survey aforesaid and denoted therein N^o 1. being the same heretofore devised to my wife during life together with all the things I have already possessed him with to him and to his heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and to my nephew Joseph Richs one tract or parcel of land containing one hundred twenty and five acres being the other moiety or half part of the two hundred and fifty acres herein particularly described and bound in the survey or plat aforesaid and denoted therein N^o 2. also the sum of three hundred pounds current money to him and to his heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and devise to my to my nephews Thomas Richs Robert Richs Richard Richs and Joseph Richs my fishing place on Netoway river in Henric County with the lands adjoining all the privileges thereunto annexed purchased by one of Richard Williams to hold to my said nephews Thomas Robert Richard & Joseph Richs and to the survivors of them their heirs & assigns forever. Also I give and devise to my nephews Robert Richs & Richard Richs after the death of my wife my spill pot tap and worm to hold to my said nephews Robert Richs & Richard Richs and to the survivor or survivors of them their heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and devise to my niece Ann Jones one Negro Girl Hannah to her and to her heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and bequeath to my niece Mary Richs after the death of my wife one large copper Kettle to her and her heirs. Also I give and bequeath to my nephews Robert Richs and Richard Richs after the death of my wife all my hogheads and barrels to be equally divided between them. Also it is my will and desire that the household lands and the interest and term yet to come in the lands leased by me of the business of the Netoway Inaction continue and
