



by my last will and Testament in manner and form following. Item, I give and bequeath to
my son Jonathan Pipe, his children Item, I give and bequeath to my son in law
Richd Pipe his children Item, I give and bequeath to my son in law
Guddings Item, I give and bequeath to all the rest of my effects should be sold and
equally divided betwixt my two other children John Pipe, wife of his first wife,
Richd Pipe Palmer Pipe, and Charity Pipe, and so hereby appoint Nathan Palmer
Executor of this my last will and Testament. Disannulling all former wills confirm-
ing this and another to be my last will and Testament in Writing whereof this 20th
Palmer Pipe hath the harkens to set her Hand and Affixed her Seal the third Day
Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and Seventy Seven
Signed sealed and delivered as her last will by Palmer her Pipe

In the Name of God Almon. This eighteenth Day of September One thousand Seven hundred and
Twenty Eight I implore Pardon of the County of Southampton Being very sick and weak
in Body but of Perfect mind and Memory and calling to mind the Mortality of my Body
and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die to make and Ordain this my
last Will and Testament First as to say first I give and Recommend my Soul into the
hands of a Almighty God and my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be Buried in Eas-
ter Christian Burial without Ditching but I shall Receive the same again by the hands
of Almighty God that gave it and as touching my worldly Effects which God of his great
Generosity hath Bestowed on me in this Life I Give Devise and Dispose of the same
in the following manner and form Item, I give and Bequeath to my loving Pipe
Mary Palmer One feather bed and Fownditioneone Grace and Side Sallies the Chayl two
Cows and Calve two Sheep and Pigge One Howard peund of Pork and all my Crops of
corn are not hereafter disposed of all which I give to her and her Heirs for ever
Item, I give to my loving Wife Mary Acconum the use of my land and Plantation together
with my Still and Conveniences also all my Household and Kitchen Furniture of
what Kind or Quality ever during her Natural life Item, I give to my son
Hastwell Newsum all the Goods of my wife my Land and Plantation Wherever I now
live with all appurtenances therewith belonging also my Water Grist Mill with one
Acre of Land on each side the said Mill together with the Stones Iron works and all
Conveniences there unto Belonging all which I give to him and his Heirs forever
Item, I give to my loving Wife Mary Acconum during her Natural life the use of Six
Negroes Namely, Hornshead, Jane, Sarah, Doll Peter and Bob, and after her Decease
I give Negroes Hornshead, Jane, Sarah, Doll Peter, and Bob to be equally divided
between my three Daughters and one Grandson Namely Agnes, Polly, Joins Mosey
Marge Armstrong, and Garrison Newsum Son of Jeffreys Newsum all which I give to
them and their Heirs forever
Item, I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Martha Johnson one Negro girl Namely
Anasha and Son Bar 9 of Indian Country Which I give to her and her Heirs forever
