of Southampton being in Sound Sense and Memory do make this my last Will & Testament
in Manner & form followeth

I Give to my Wife Mary a third Part of my land to be laid off by John Switer Senr.
Cordal Benefactor John Blount & John Bradford also One Load of Hay Ten Bar of Corn
one Sow and pig one Cow & half one Feather Bed and Furniture one Caven one Dish & two
Plates one Pot & Pan one Tree and Lamb One spinning Wheel and one Pair of Cotton Cates one
Loom one Slay & 1 Canister During her life then it to be Divided between W^m. Thomas & Hulin
Then I Give to my son W^m. Thomas the Profits of the Other two thirds of my land.

Then I Give my land whereon I now live to my son William at my Wife's Death and if he Die
Without Issue of his body lawfully begotten to be Equally Divided Between Thomas & Hulin
Then I Give the land I bought of W^m. Doid to my son Thomas after my Wife's Death and
if he Die Without heir of his body lawfully begotten then it to be Equally Divided
Between William & Hulin.

Then I Give my Son Hulin my Still and if he Die Without heir of his body lawfully
begotten then it to be Equally Divided between William & Thomas.

Then I Give my Daughter Milly Johnson Two Cows and yearlings already in her
Possession.

Then I Give my Daughter Ann Williams One Cow & half already in her Possession

Then I Give my Daughter Rebecca Phillips one Feather bed already in her Possession

Then I Give my Daughter Mary Truings One Feather bed already in her Possession

Then I Give my son Loom Two shillings

Then I Give my son Jerry Five shillings

I leave my Negro Fellow Tharper to be sold and the Money to be Equally Divided be-
tween my three sons William, Thomas & Hulin.
