

Also, I Give devise and bequeath to my son Jacob Barnes the plantation of Lands which I bought of Rich^d. Johnson containing by estimation Two hundred Twenty five acres Likewise all the remainder of my lands lying in the broad swamp flattery Gun of the house on branch, being the whole of two tracts one purchased of Arthur Allen containing Two hundred acres more or less the other of Matthew Johnson containing One hundred acres more or less, the whole of the said three tracts several pieces of land being severally and distinctly bounded and described by three several acres for the same from the aforesaid Rich^d. Johnson, Arthur Allen, & Matthew Johnson, to me, also after the death of wife the plantation of Lands whereon I live containing by estimation Two hundred acres, also all my Lands known by the name of the pine woods containing by estimation one hundred acres & bound by the Lands of Alldridge Jones Jordan Denson, Jacob Jenkins, Lewis Sogard & also one negro girl called Jude one Featherhead of Furniture two Cows & calves two sows and piggs one Ewe and Lamb Ten pounds value in pewter silver flag bottom, 6 chairs and one Iron pot the whole to him & his heirs and assigns forever also one small colt called blaze.

Also, I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Johnson wife of Stephen Johnson One Negro boy called Sel together with sundry things all of which she hath already been possessed with to her & to her heirs and assigns forever.

Also I Give and bequeath unto Peninah Barnes One negro boy called Tom one Featherhead and furniture one Cow and calf eight pounds value in pewter one Ewe & Lamb & one chest to her & to her heirs & assigns forever.

Also, I Give and bequeath to my daughter Milly Barnes one negro boy called Mingo one Featherhead & Furniture the value of eight pounds in pewter one Chest one Cow and calf and one Ewe & Lamb to her & to her heirs and assigns forever.

Also, I Give All The remainder of my estate of what nature or kind soever real personal or mixed whether in possession remainder or reversion (after my just debts & other necessary expences are first paid and satisfied) I leave to my wife Mary Barnes for & during the time of her natural life, and after her death It is my will and desire and I do hereby order direct that all the said remainder and residue part of my estate be equally divided, between all my children to wit John Barnes William Barnes, Jacob Barnes, Mary, Johnson Peninah Barnes, & Milly Barnes, or to their heirs.

Lastly, I do hereby constitute deputy or agent & appoint my wife Wife Mary Barnes my friend George Washington Son of George and my son William Barnes my whole & sole Executors to this my last Will & Testament & I do hereby ratify & confirm this my last will & no other to be my Last & Testament revoking & annulling all former Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Twentieth day of August In the year of our Lord Christ One thousand Seven hundred twenty & nine
