

Also I give devise and bequeath to my son Jacob Barnes the plantation of Lands which I bought of Richd^r Johnson containing by estimation Two hundred Twenty five acres likewise all the remainder of my lands lying in the broad swamp Hagg^r Cane & the horse pen branch, being the whole of two tracts one purchased of Arthur Allen containing Two hundred acres more or less the other of Matthew Johnson containing One hundred acres more or less the whole of the said three tracts and messures of land being severally and distinctly bounded and described by three several lines for the same from the aforesaid Richd^r Johnson, Arthur Allen & Matthew Johnson, to me, also after the death of wife the plantation of lands whereon I live containing by estimation Two hundred acres, also all my Lands known by the name of the pine woods containing by estimation one hundred acres yea and by the Lands of Albridgeston Jones, Jordan, Denson, Jacob Johnson, Lewis, Sogano & also one negro girl called Jude one feather bed & Furniture two Cows & calves two sow and piggs one Cewe and Lamb Ten pounds value in powder six flag bottomed Chains and one Iron pot the whol to him & his heirs and assigns forever. also one sorrel colt called Blasge.

Also, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Johnson wife of Stephen Johnson one Negro boy called Set together with sundry things all of which she hath already been possessed with to her & to her heirs and assigns forever.

Also I give and bequeath unto Penninah Barnes one negro boy called Tom one feather bed and furniture one Cow and calf eight pounds value in powder one Ewe & lamb & one chest to her & to her heirs & assigns forever.

Also I give and bequeath to my daughter Milly Barnes one negro boy called Moses one feather bed & Furniture the value of eight pounds in powder one Chest one Cow and calf and one Ewe & lamb to her & to her heirs & assigns forever.

Also All the remainder of my estate of what nature or kind soever real personal or mist whether in possession remainder or reversion (after my just executors and other necessary expenses are first paid and satisfied) I leave to my wife Mary Barnes for during the time of her natural life, and after her death it is my will and desire and I do hereby order direct that all the remainder and residue part of my estate be equally divided, between all my children to wit John Barnes William Barnes, Jacob Barnes, Mary Johnson, Penninah Barnes, & Milly Barnes, or to their heirs.

Lastly, I do hereby constitute depose and arraign & appoint my wife wife Mary Barnes, my friend George Washington Son of George and my son William Barnes my whole y^r sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament & I do hereby ratify & confirm this my last will & no other to be my last Will & Testament revoking & canceling all former Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Twenty day of August in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand Seven hundred twenty three
