

In the Name of God Amen, I David Burn of Southampton County of the Commonwealth of Virginia being sick & infirm but of sound & perfect use of my mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality & uncertainty of this transitory life knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do think proper to make Constitution & Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following to wit Item, I give unto my son David Burn two Shillings & six pence Court of Law & Justice of Virginia to him & his heirs forever Item, I give the lawfull heir of my Daughter Martha Whales two Shillings & six pence to him & his heirs forever Item, I give to my Daughter Eliz K. Masons lawfull heir two Shillings & six pence to him & his heirs forever Item, I give to my Daughter Rebecca Vaughan two Shillings & six pence to her & her heirs forever Item, I give to my Daughter Mary Councill two Shillings & six pence to her & her heirs forever Item, I give to the lawfull heir of my late son John Burn two Shillings & six pence to them & their heirs forever Item, I give to my son Harry Burn two Shillings & six pence to him & his heirs forever Item, I leave to my loving Wife my Negro woman named Hannah a young negro woman named Leah to my wife Patience Burn during her natural life & after her death the s<sup>t</sup> two Negroes & other Incomes to be equally divided between my two daughters Ann Burn & Sarah Councill to them of their heirs forever Item, I give to my daughter Ann Burn one Negro Girl named Millie to her & her heirs forever Item, I give to my loving Wife Patience Burn one Negro Girl named pale to her & her heirs forever Item, I give all the remainder of my Estate after my wife die<sup>t</sup> to be equally divided between my two daughters Ann Burn & Sarah Councill to them of their heirs forever Lastly I do hereby nominate & chuse my son in law Cutchen Councill my wholsely & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament Reserving all other Wills hereunto made by me in Writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 2<sup>d</sup> day of October One thousand Seven hundred & seventy nine David + Burn Seal  
Signed Sealed & Delivered at a Court held for the County of Southampton March 8<sup>th</sup> day of Novr 1779 This Will was proven to be in County Cutchen Councill the Executor therin named proved by the Oath of Cutchen Councill & Joseph Mountfort the Notary Publick to be proved and on the motion of the s<sup>r</sup> Executor who made oath according to law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a Poclat in due form giving security wherupon he Tom Kelly Jr

I Give unto my grand daughter Elizabeth Councill one Negro Girl named pale to her heirs; containing this 1<sup>st</sup> day of Novr 1779 this last Will & Testament Testified up witness the said Patience Burn hath hereunto set her hand & seal this Fifth day of Novr One Thousand Seven hundred Seventy Nine

Signed Sealed published pronounced and delivered by the said Patience Burn to her self Will & Testament Interpreted by Joseph Mountfort At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 11<sup>th</sup> day of Novr 1779 This Will was proved by the oath of Joseph Mountfort Patience Burn Seal  
The death Lewis She death Lewis the Notary Publick whose Oath is to be Recorded. And on the Motion of Southwicks Council who made oath according to law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a Poclat in due form giving security wherupon he Sam Kelly Jr
