

I give to my two Daughters Sarah Clements & Elizabeth Clements my Plantation in
Brunswick County containing Six hundred & Eighty Acres to be Equally Divided between
them having agreed to the quantity as well as Quantity I give it to them of whom
ever I also give to my 1^o Daughter my Stock of Cattle & Horses & Sheep & Waggons
that may be of Everyhond on the Plantation to be Equally divided Except my
Cows called Namea Paine which I give to my Son Francis.

Item I give my Wife Elizabeth Clements my Negro Wench Nam to to her John her Servant
I give her the Rest of this Plantation wherein I now live during her life Containing nine
Hundred Acres after her Death I give it to my Son John Clements after his heirs for ever
also I give them the Rest of the following Slaves during her life to wit Jack Toney
and Caesar Monah Talbot & Black Alice All my Stock of Cows kind that may be
on my Plantation & the Cows of Everyhond together with the Rest of my Households
& Kitchen Furniture of Plantation Paternalls and at her Death I give the Stock
& Cows Cattle & Sheep & Waggons that may be left at her Death to my Son

John Clements & his Heirs And all my Households & Kitchen Furniture that
may be left at the Death of my Wife and all my Other Estates not mentioned no
being given away to be Equally divided between my two Sons Francis & John Clements
and I do nominate & appoint my Brother Thos Clements Thos Clements Bulles & Doctor
Thos. Pitts Executore of this my last will & Testament to make & execute for me & Do & Will
Other Wills or form of wills by me made declaring this to be my last will & testa-
ment in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this eleventh day
of Sept. One thousand Seven hundred and Seventy-Eight.

In the Name of God Amen I command & require of Southampton County Virginia being Sick &
weak but of sound mind memory to make & constitute this my last Will & Testament as
follows In the first place I command my Soul to God my Body to the Earth to be buried in
a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executor of a way that God by his
will pleased God to bestow upon me I give & bequeath as follows
I desire that my Executor hereafter named sell as much of my Estates as will pay
my just debts

I give unto to my loving Wife Sarah Jenkins the use of my Plantation wherein I now live
(my Still Cows, Horses & Hulthorn Excepted) Stock of Cattle Horses Sheep & Waggons the Cows thereon
Plantation Utensils household & Kitchen Furniture with my Negroes Brister, Simon, Joe
Profey, Simon & Tom during her Natural life

I give unto my Son Valentine Jenkins the Plantation or Tract of Land wherein he now
lives my Negro Brister my Still Cows & Horses & Hulthorn to him and his heirs for ever and at the death
of my wife I give unto my said Son the Plantation wherein I now live with my Negro Brister
& Simon to him and his heirs for ever
