 between my two children Valentine & Helen, or in case of the death of either
 before that time to their surviving children, And lastly I constitute & appoint
 my son Valentine sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament Caring
 all the Wills by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand & affixed my Seal this death day of October One thousand Seven
 hundred & Seventy Nine

In the Name of God Amen. I David Edmunds of Southampton County being of Sound &
 Disposing mind and memory; thank to be to Almighty God, as made that my last Will &
 Testament, in manner & form following (to wit)
 Item, I Give to my Wife Ann Edmunds, the use of the Plantation whereon I now live during
 her life, likewise Three Hundred and Ten Acres of Land being the whole of the Tracts
 Tract Together with. half the Profit of my Grise Mills provided she bear half the Expence
 of Repairing her, I likewise give to my Wife Ten Negroes namely Jacob & Wife to her
 for ever for ever of the labour of the Ten following Slaves during her widowhood, namely
 Dick, Ben, Ananias, Ishmael, Tony, Jalya, as to Lydia Children my wife may please
 to my William at her pleasure, I likewise give to my wife Ann One third part of my Cattle.
 One half of my Stock of Hogs, One third part of my Sheep and One half of the Cost of
 what kind of corn that is or may be made on my Plantation's this present Year I also give my
 wife One Featherbed & 100 Linnen, three Red Cattle, 10 Acres (to wit) Derrick, Doll & her
 Annetotte fully my own is that my Wife keep all my House hold Furniture during
 her widowhood, Legacies Excepted. I then be sole by my Executor the money arising from
 the sale thereof to be Equally divided between my three Children, Howell, Mary & William
 Item, I give & Bequeath to my son Howell Edmunds the following Tracts of Land (to wit) the
 Plantation and Tract of Land he now lives on containing Four hundred Acres more or
 less the Land purchased of Ben. Clements likewise the Tract of Land I purchased of
 Correll Knabst containing One hundred Acres more or less, Colld. Ditcher like wise the
 Land I purchased of William Bouce containing One hundred & thirty Acres more or less
 Also a Tract of Land containing One hundred Acres more or less known by the name of the
 Marsh Land. I likewise give to my son Howell Edmunds the following Slaves namely, Julia
 Lancy, Dick Smith, Felt, Abraham, Boatman Sarah, Abby, Venus & seven
 Together with their future increase to him for his heirs forever, I likewise give to my son
 How. Edmunds one Negro boy named Jack one Negro boy named George one Negro boy named Tony
 to him for his heirs forever also one Negro woman named Dick After the decease of my wife Ann
 I likewise give to my son Howell Ten Featherbeds & 100 Linnen One of which already received
 likewise one Black walnut desk already received.
