

Now, I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Dawson the following Negro namely,
 Polly, Phill, Doll, Rachel, Pinner, Patricia, Cato, Calah, Henry, Jesse, Phill,
 & Phill. Together with their Issue I increase to her their Heirs for ever. Likewise and
 my Negro Girl named Annarchy after the Marriage of my wife Ann together with her
 Heirs to her their Heirs for ever — Likewise one Black Walnut Desk after the
 Marriage of my wife Ann also Two Feather beds of Furniture which she has
 already Received —
 Now, I give & bequeath to my Son William Edwards the following Tracts of Land viz
 a Tract Containing Two hundred Acres more or less whereon he now lives also a Tract of
 Land Comprehending of Richd Taylor's Containing Two Hundred Acres more or less. I
 likewise give to my Son William after the Marriage or Death of my wife Two other
 Tracts of Land (to wit) the Plantation whereon I now live Containing One Hundred
 Fifty Acres more or less and a Tract Containing Three Hundred & Fifty Acres more
 or less whereon my first Will stands, which said also mentioned Land I give to
 him his Heirs forever. I give to my Son William Edwards the following Slaves
 viz Lewis, Stephen, Hannah, John, Fanny, Phebe, Henry, Amos together with their
 Issue I increase to him their Heirs for ever. Also I give to my Son William after the
 Marriage of my wife Ann One Negro Man named Ben One Negro Man named
 Ephraim, and Negro Woman named Phill, one Negro Girl named Phill one Negro woman
 named Lettie, Negro Girl named Phill, with their Issue I increase to him their Heirs
 forever. Also Two Feather beds of Furniture one of which he has already Received. Also
 one third of my Stock of Cattle the third of my Stock of Sheep the 1/3 of the profits of
 my first mill, Provided he be at half the Expence of Repairing her in Repair. Also
 one Black Walnut Desk which he has already Received together with the Wal-
 nut Bench that is now in the House, also my Copper Still after the Marriage of
 my wife, Also my Smiths Forge Provided he will have the Smiths work done
 by the Mill during my wife's Widowhood. My desire is, that the Lands Inheri-
 tance of Oliver Day & William Francis be sold by Executors hereafter mentioned & the
 money arising from the sale thereof be Equally Divided between my three
 children Hannah, Mary, & William Edwards my record is that after my first Will
 & Funeral Expence & Taxes are paid the Remainder of Ready Money if any be Equally
 Divided between my wife & three Children above mentioned; My desire is, that my
 Walnut Timber be Divided between my three Children above mentioned
 I do Appoint my Son Howell Edwards John Dawson & William Edwards Execu-
 tors to this my last Will & Testament, as Witnesses my hand & Seal this Twenty first
 day of July, One Thousand Seven hundred & Eighty & Nine
