In the Name of God Amen. I Charles Bapf of the County of Southampton being sick and weak of body but of sound and disposing mind and memory thankes be to Almighty God for the same, to make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in the following manner Vizd.

Imprimis. After my Funeral Expences are defayed and just debts paid I discharge of my worldly Goods both Real and Personal which is hath pleased Almighty God of his Mercy and goodness to bestow on me as followeth with

Item. I give & bequeath to my Son Henry Bapf and to his Heirs forever all the part of my Land lying on the south side of the Road leading from Southampton towards to Rivers Ford containing as is estimated two hundred Acre, be the same more or less.

Item. I lived with my Son Hansiman Bapf during his Natural Life a part of my Land bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at the main Run of the Three Creeches where the dividing line between Jeremiah Thorpe and myself striketh the Creek, thence up the said Creek to the mouth of the Beaver pond from thence down a Run which run through the low ground called the back run to within and beyond the corner of the Jeremiah Thorpe line aforesaid, thence a straight course to his noted Pine which lies soon lately fell avunder within a few steps of the Masses Branch, thence to the Meadow Branch and up the same to the Meadow from thence a straight line to the corner of the s^r Jeremiah Thorpe Land near the s^r Meadow then down the s^r Jeremiah Thorpe line to the beginning imagined to be one hundred Acre to the same more or less, provided my son Hansiman Bapf should depart this Life before the death of his Wife Anna Bapf then I lend the s^r Land to the s^r Anna Bapf during her widowhood, I give & bequeath to my Grandson Roger Bapf and to his Heirs forever the last mentioned parcels of land of one hundred Acre after the incumbrance above is removed.

Item. I give & bequeath to my Neighbour Jacob Foster three acres of Land to him the s^r Thorpe and to his Heirs forever beginning where the line which divides the s^r Thorpe Land from mine striketh a Run called the back run of the Three Creeches, thence down the s^r back run until opposite to the corner of my old house to a Poplar standing in the Hedges near the Cartway Thorpe house and my house, thence to a Branch which divideth
