In the Name of God Amen. I Charles Bafo of the County of Southampton being Sick and weak of body but of sound and disposing mind and memory, thank be to Almighty God for the same, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in the following manner. Viz.

Imprimis, After my Funeral Expences are payed, and just debts paid I dispose of my worldly Goods both Real and Personal which it hath pleased Almighty God of his Mercy and goodness to bestow on me as follows to wit:

Item I give & bequeath to my Son Henry Bafo and to his Heirs for ever all the part of my Land lying on the south side of the Road leading from Southampton Court house to Hives Ford containing as is estimated two hundred Acres, be the same more or less.

Item I land unto my Son Benjamin Bafo during his Natural Life a part of my Land bounded as follows to wit, beginning at the main Run of the Three Creeks where the dividing land between Jeremiah Thorpe and myself strikes the s^r. Creek, thence up the said Creek to the mouth of the Beaver pond from thence down a Run which runs through the low ground called the back run to within one hundred Yards of the s^r. Jeremiah Thorpe line aforesaid, thence a straight Course to two noted Pines which lie down lately fell avunder within a few steps of the Meadows Branch, thence to the Meadows Branch and up the same to the Meadows from thence a straight line to the Corner tree of the s^r. Jeremiah Thorpe Land near the s^r. Meadows then down the s^r. Jeremiah Thorpe line to the beginning, imagined to be One hundred Acres be the same more or less, provided my s^r. Son Benjamin Bafo should depart this Life before the death of his Wife Ann Bafo then I land the s^r. Land to the s^r. Ann Bafo during her Widowhood, I give & bequeath to my Grandson Roger Bafo and to his Heirs for ever the last mentioned parcel of Land of one hundred Acres after the incumbrance above is removed.

Item, I give & bequeath to my Neighbour Moses Thorpe Twelve Acres of Land to him the s^r. Thorpe and to his Heirs for ever beginning where the land which divides the s^r. Thorpe Land from mine strikes a Run called the back run of the Three Creeks, thence down the s^r. back run untill opposite to the corner of my old field thence to a Poplar standing in the Hedge row near the Carters Thorpe house and my house, thence to a Branch which divides
