Item, I give to my son Charles Basse during his Natural life the remaining part of my Land which I imagine is one hundred and fifty three and shoud my 2^d son Charles depart this life before his wife dies then I give the same of the 2^d last parcel of Land to my 2^d son Charles's wife Ann Basse during her widowhood.

Item, I give to my Grandson Lewis Basse and his Heirs for ever the 2^d parcel of Land which I have given his Father Charles Basse the use of during Natural Life if his Father during his widowhood (as the case maybe) after the two incumbrances are at an end but should the 2^d son depart this life before the 2^d two incumbrances are removed then I give the 2^d parcel of Land to his Brother Diakon Basse and to his Heirs forever but should the 2^d Diakon behave as did under the same situation and circumstances, then on the 2^d time I give to his Brother Howell Basse the 2^d parcel of Land last mentioned to him the 2^d Howell Basse and to his Heirs for ever.

Item I give to my Grandson Diakon Basse my midling six Rods and Hooks

Item, My wife and I give in, that my Burial place belonging to the parcel of Land I have last to my son Charles Basse to the sign of the Baptist Church square shall be reserved for a family burial place and I do not give this burial place to any person whatsoever notwithstanding the before bequested.

Item, My Wife is that all the remainder part of my Potatoes in whatsoever manner it lyeth or may be found (except a Quarter of Bush of Potatoes proper to me) which I give to my son Charles, forth for a Baiting of Trout or which I make these to come which I give to my Daughter Mary (Matthews) shall be sold to the highest Bidder for ready money

and the money arising from the 2^d sale to be Equally divided between my Sons Arthur Basse, Isaac Basse, my Daughter Mary Matthews of my Grandson Isaac Basse son of my Daughter Tabitha Basse.

Item, I do nominate & appoint my Sons Henry Basse & Charles Basse & my son in law Arthur Matthews my whole Exors. & of this my last Will & Testament, In Witness whereof I do hereby set my hand & Affix my Seal this Eleventh Day of September 1780.
