

In The Name of God Amens I Thomas Cronshaw of Southampton County living rich and well in Body but in Perfect mind & memory thankes to God for it and calling unto me the Mortality of my Body and knowing it is appointed for all to die do make of Present this my last Will & Testimony principally and first of all I Recommand my Soul into the Hand of Almighty God of my Body to the Ground to be Buried in a Christian like manner And as touching such worldly Estates which it bath Pleasid God to Bless me with in this life I give in the following manner & form I give to my Son John Cronshaw the plantation wherch I now Dwell of One Hundred and Fifty Acres of Land that joine the same which I Purchasid of William West and Recorded to be Joseph West Alles Fifty Acres of Land granted to me by Pattent date Augt. the Sixteenth 1746 Alles One Hundred and Fifteen Acres more or less that joins the Afores One hundred and fifty acres being Part of a Plantation Granted to me by Pattent dated Augt. the Twentieth 1745 and Divided from the other part of this Pattent by a line of Chestnut Trees made by me Beginning on the Pattent line at a small maple standing in a small Branch near the South west corner of James Daughtry's Plantation then near a west corner to a Little Oak Standing near the Head of a small Branch former Mr. Jones Old Mill upon Hulpeach Road and in the line of the Land I Purchased of Robert Carter to him and his Heirs forever.

I give to my Daughter Amy Bailey the use of the Plantation of Land I Purchased of Robert Carter during her natural life & at her decease I give the said Plantation and Land to her Son Samuel Magot Cronshaw and to his Heirs and for the want of such & if in I give the said Land & Plantation to my Apos^d Daughter Amy Bailey & her and her Heirs forever &c.

I give to my Daughter Ann Cronshaw all the Remainder of my Land with the Appurtenance to her and her Heirs forever.

As for all the Possessions of my Estate be it in any kind or Qualitie whatsoever I give to be Equally Dividid Among my Three Children if they can agree on a Division if not then to be Sold by my Executors and the Money arising from such sale to be Equally Dividid Amongst them to them & their Heirs forever &c.

I do appoint my Son John Cronshaw Nicholas Magot & Sibyl Whitehead my hols Esqrs to this my last Will Revoking all other Wills by me before made Ratifying this and no Other to be my last Will & Testament in Writing whereof I signe this^d Thomas Cronshaw hath counterset with my Hand & Seal this second Sixteenth Day of Octo: One thousand Seven hundred & Sixty Eight
