I give of Bequeath to my Niece Fanny Newson my Negro Girl Sall to her & her Heirs forever

I give of Bequeath to my Niece Lucy Newson my Negro Girl Rachell to her & her Heirs forever.

The Remainder of my Estate (Consisting of my Land, Stock of Horses Cattle & Hogs, Crop of Corn &c.) to be Sold and the Money Arising for the same to be Equally divided between my Brother Newt Harris, Thomas Harris Nathan Harris & my Sister Martha Newson.

and my Will and is that Cordall Kiffleet & my Brother Nathan Harris be Executors of this my Last Will of Testament as above mentioned. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Affixed my Seal this Fifthteenth day of September Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred & Eighty.
