 I give & Bequeath to my Brother Nathan Harris, my Negro man Will my negro Girl Bette my Negro boy Peter & my Negro Girl Pegg, to him and his Heirs forever.

I give & Bequeath to my Niece Fanny Newsum my Negro Girl Sall to her & her Heirs forever.

I give & Bequeath to my Niece Lucy Newsum my Negro Girl Rachell to her & her Heirs forever.

The Remainder of my Estate (Consisting of my Land, Stock of Horse Cattle & Hogs, Crop of Corn &c.) to be Sold and the Money Arising for the same to be Equally divided between my Brother Nisbet Harris, Thomas Harris Nathan Harris & my Sister Martha Newsum, and my Will and is that Cordall Kistler & my Brother Nathan Harris be Executors of this my Last Will & Testament as above mentioned, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Affixed my Seal this Tenth day of September Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred & Eighty.
