

In the eⁿ Year of God O'mon, I Thomas Sanktford of Southampton County Virginias being rich and in good fleshy, but of sound perfect and disposing mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of this transitory life & knowing that it is appointed for all men to die, do think proper to make this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following to witness.

I give & send to my dear and loving wife Elizabeth Sanktford the uses profits and advantages of the plantation and lands wherein I now live to include all the lands I bought of William Hobday, and of Allington Whitley supposed to contain two hundred thirty seven acres also my negro man Bromfield Lambes boy, James negro woman Pat, and Jim, one bay mare, one filly and one she horse called Beck, sixteen head of the best of my horned cattle, sixteen of the like kind of my sheep all my hoggs all my pigs. Likewise all my household & kitchen Furniture plantation implements and tools of all kinds, also a sufficient part of my crop of every kind back and salt for the support of her and her family from the time of my death demises until the end of the year or whilst she hath made a crop of her own. The whole of the above I give her for and during the term of her natural life a widow & had no longer. Likewise Give her one barrel of Brandy.

Also I give devise and Bequeath to my son Alsha Sanktford The plantation and lands which I bought of Wade Mountfordin supposed to contain one hundred eighty acres likewise the lands I bought of William Glover, called the orchard tract containing by estimation one hundred acres also one other tract called the Island Land supposed to contain eighty acres which I likewise bought of William Glover the whole comprised bounded and described as by the said Wade Mountfordin deed and W^m Glovers two deeds to me is severally separately and distinctly expressed, also my hunting Gun my riding Saddle and bridle, as much money as shall be sufficient to build him a house, in his plantation of the size and equally as good as the one in which I now dwell, being that nearest the road) with a ten foot shed thereto instead of eight feet likewise one cow and calf of one heifer which I direct may be kept for him on his plantation to him and to his Heires and assigns forever.

Also I give devise and Bequeath to my son Jefre Sanktford The plantation plants I bought of William Barrett wherean James Wilson now lives containing by estimation One hundred and fifty acres bounded and described as by the said Barretts deed to me is declared and expressed to him and to his Heires and assigns forever, Also Give him my Squirrel Gun.

Also I give devise and Bequeath to my son Jope Sanktford after the death or marriage of my wife The plantation and lands wherein I now live Comprising the lands I bought of Mr Hobday supposed to be ten acres and the lands I bought of Allington Whitley supposed to contain two hundred & Twenty seven acres severally and dealt and described as by the s^r Mr Hobdays deed of Allington Whitley deceased same is expressed likewise my copper still pot & p^t of iron to him to be assigns forever.
