pounds Eighteen Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him & his Heirs for ever
but in Case my Brother William Avel never Returne I give the S^d Money to be
Equally Divided between my Three Sisters Jeannett West, Maryning Avel &
Charlotte Avel to them and their Heirs for ever. And I do hereby constitute &
appoint my Friend Samuel Edwards the Elder of this my last Will &
Testament An Executor whereof I have Received set my hand and Affixed my
Seal this Twelfth Day of April One thousand seven hundred & seventy nine.

her Heirs for ever. Also I give to my Daughter Susanna Gleston Two Shillings Lawfull Currency
of Virginia to be raised & paid out of my personal Estate to her & her Heirs forever.

Thirdly I give & bequeath to my Son John Haily two hundred Acres of land whereon he
now lives to him & his Heirs forever. Also I give & bequeath to my Son John Haily two Shillings
Lawfull Currency of Virginia to be raised & paid out of my personal Estate to him & his Heirs
forever. Also I give & bequeath to my Son John Haily at my death one Negro boy named
Daniel to him & his Heirs forever.

Fourthly I give & bequeath to my Daughter Polly Pond after my Death one Negro Girl
named Pleasant to her & her Heirs for ever. Also I give & bequeath to my Daughter Polly
Two Shillings Lawfull Currency of Virginia to be raised & paid out of my personal
Estate to her & her Heirs for ever.
