testament in manner and form following to wit.

I give and bequeath unto Anthony Kinnelius all my Land and Plantation
whence my Father land containing three hundred acres more or less to
him and his Heirs forever and bequeath one Negro Man Calis Bittler to him
the said Anthony and his heirs for ever.

Item, My will and desire is that after my just debts and Funeral charges are paid
that all the Money that is due to my Estate on what Account ever, I give and
bequeath to Mrs. Bittler Kinnelius and her Heirs for ever.

Item, I give and bequeath to Shadrach Kinnelius one Negro girl Calis Chana
to the said Shadrach and his heirs for ever.

Item, Lastly I do appoint my well beloved friend John Banow and my loving
Brother Shadrach Kinnelius Executors of this my last Will and Testament
disannulling all other Wills by me herebefore made. and do acknowledge
and declare this to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this 4th of Nov^r. 1780.

In the Name of God Amen, I James Lundy of the County of Southampton being of sound
and disposing mind do make this my last will and Testament as follows:
First, I give to my niece Mary Lundy daughter of Boyd Lundy at to her have the
plantation where my Father lived and all the lands both high and low which I suppose
that were given to my Uncle by my said Father will including the two pounds which by
his S^t. will were annexed to me for life and also the land Lundy purchased of John Lundy
I also give her the absolute property of this even following slaves & their increase
from this date viz, Rose Rachael, Abraham, Orenge, Calis, Wining & Gammie also
I give her the still on the said plantation, my curtain bed & Furniture and a wash tub.

Also, I give to my cousin James Lundy son of Robert Lundy the plantation where
I now live being the residue of the land I prefer to him and to his heirs also the
absolute property of his Negro wife Aggy and her daughter Abby and their increase from
this date together with the still on the said plantation. It is my desire that James Lundy
the said James Lundy to occupy the house on the main road as long as he
lives & for his heirs & fencing from the woods adjoining without making waste.
Also I give to John Lundy back wall round his grange near my house from I derive my
said cousin should perform that business and these legacies to him are hereby given him
on these conditions.

Also I give to my cousin Sarah Lundy daughter of Robert Lundy two Negroes & their
increase from this date viz Hannah & Sam to her and her heirs.

Also I give to Lucy Morris sister to Christian Morris and to her heirs a negro man

key and her postures increase.
