

In the Name of God Amen, I Edwin Kinnelbrow of Sten County and Parish of St. Andrew being sick and weak of body, but in perfect and sound memory thank be to Almighty God for the same, do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit:

First I give and bequeath unto Henry Kinnelbrow all my land and plantation wherein my Father lived containing three hundred acres more or less to him and his heirs forever and determined one Negro Man Gals Bonwell to him he said Henry and his heirs for ever.

Item My will and desire is that after my last debts and Funeral Charges are paid that all the Money that is due to my Estate on what Account soever I give and bequeath to Phileas Kinnelbrow and his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to Shadrach Kinnelbrow one Negro Girl Gals Chinas to him & Shadrach and his heirs for ever.

Item Lastly I do appoint my well beloved friend John Barrow and my loving Brother Shadrach Kinnelbrow Executors of this my last Will and Testament disannulling all other Wills by me heretofore made, and do acknowledge and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 4th of Nov^r. 1780.

As a Court held for the County of Sten the 8th day of Feb^r. 1781. This Will was presented in Court by John Barrow that appeared therein names and proved by the oaths of Phileas Kinnelbrow & Phoebe A. Barrow two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded. And on the Motion of the Executor who made oath according to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a Probate in due form giving Security whereupon &c.

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In the Name of God Amen, I James Lundy of the County of Southampton being of sound and disposing memory do make this my last will and Testament as followeth.

First I give to my niece Mary Lundy daughter of Robert Lundy all to have him the plantation wherein my Father lived and all the lands both high and low which I possess that were given to Henry Lundy by my said Father with including the low grounds which by the said will were devised to me for life and also the land Mary purchased of Shadrach Lundy I also give her the absolute property of the seven following Slaves & their increase from this date viz, Pava Rachael Abraham, Orange, Calix, Winny & Estamie also I give her the still on the said plantation, my curtain bed & Furniture and as was lately due. Also I give to my cousin James Lundy son of Robert Lundy the plantation wherein I now live being the residue of the land I possess to him and to his heirs also the absolute property of the Negro viz, Aggy and her daughter Abby and their increase from this date together with the still on the said plantation. It is my desire that James Lundy should suffer William Jameson to occupy the house on the main road as long as he should desire before he shall be obliged to leave the house and the land about the house &c. for ever & coming from the woods gathering without making waste. And I do before God & the world record the goods & personal estate I devise my said cousin should possess that bequeathed and these legacies to him are hereby given him on that condition.

Also I give to my niece Sarah Lundy daughter of Robert Lundy two Negroes & their increase from this date viz, Hannah & Carter to her and her heirs.

Also I give to George Maria sister to Elizabeth Maria and to her heirs a negro named Mary and her future increase.
