Now My will I desire is that all the Debts due from the Sale of my Estate be satisfied in the clearest and shortest but at the Direction of my Executor / put out on Int. for the benefit of these my Grand Children, or given up into the Hands of their Father or Guardians.

And by law, an Inventory of all my Estate are required. I Expect my Executor will comply with that, but I direct that no Appointment of it be made. And lastly I do appoint my Son Timothy Thos. whole Just Executor of this my last will & Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 11. day of Dec: 1780. Signed sealed published & Declared by the Testator to be her last will in presence of Hardy Davier Martha ^l Jones Sally Jewell & Sarah ^l Gasky.

This being my last Will and Testament, I leave my Son Arthur Byrd my Executor.
