 unto my Son Arthur Byrd my Box of Jewellery.
 I give and bequeath unto my Son John Byrd five Shillings and every the son I have
 James Byrd, Charles Byrd, Philip Byrd, Major Byrd and Nathan Byrd.
 This being my last Will and Testament, I leave my Son Arthur Byrd my Executor.
