

Now I give and bequeath to my son Henry and to his heirs my now house with all
 the land there adjoining the same after dividing and taking there from what land
 I have given to my son Edward Taylor and the land I have lent to my wife
 which land so lent after her decease I give to my said son Henry & his heirs
 Now, My Will and desire is that if my son Henry Taylor should die under age that
 all the land given him may go to my son John Taylor & his heirs as in &c
 Now, I desire that the residue of my estate I have specified both real and personal be
 sold for Money or Tob: as my Executors may think best which when collected I desire
 may be laid out together with the whole money or tobacco I may have by fine or debt to me
 by my Executors or the purchase of them in the purchase of young Slaves the greater part to
 Now, I desire that the residue of my Slaves and those to be purchased by my Executors
 may be hired out for the support and maintenance and education of my son Henry and
 my daughter Charlotte, Mary, and Martha, until my daughter Charlotte shall arrive at
 the age of twenty one or be married at which period there are to be negroes taken from
 this stock of equal value to the negroes given to my daughter Elizabeth for each of
 my said Daughters, Charlotte, Mary, and Martha. The value to be ascertained
 according to the value of the negroes given Elizabeth when she shall receive them which
 said negroes so taken from the residue aforesaid I give to my said Daughters Char-
 lotte, Mary, & Martha separately to them & their heirs
 Now, The residue of the Slaves as well those lent to my wife as every other together
 with every other article that may be remaining of those lent my wife at her decease
 I give to my son Henry and to his heirs for ever
 Now, My Will and desire is that if either of my children should die under age and
 not married that all the Slaves and personal estate given to such child or children
 as dying be equally divided between such of my said children as shall survive
 and their heirs
 Now I do appoint my Executors or the survivor of them Guardian to my Son and
 my wife's guardian to my Daughter during her life and after her death my ex-
 cutors aforesaid
 Now, I desire that the guardians to my son Henry may send him to the College
 or such other schools as they may judge best and as long as they may think
 convenient and then place him by indenture to some business such as his own
 inclination, and natural genius may lead to
 Now, I desire that no appraisement be made of my Estate. Lastly I do ap-
 point my son Edward Taylor and my friend Daniel Fisher Executors of this my
 last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made In
 Witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal this eighth day of March 1781.
