In the Name of God Amen I Benjamin Turner of Southampton County being of
Perfect mind and Memory doth make this my last Will and Testament as follows
Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Benjamin Turner, my Tract of land whereon
now lies with a part of another Tract Wapping Bought of David Edmunds, bounded
by the nearest wanch that leads from Copel Swamp, near to Thomas Porter land
and thence from the head thereof a straight Course to the said Porters land, to him
and his heirs forever.

Item I give & Bequeath unto my son Henry Turner the Remainder of said
Tract Bought of said Edmunds, to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give & Bequeath unto my son Nathan Turner my Tract of Land whereon
is now lies, it being on the South side of Flat Swamp, to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Benjamin Turner, my Negro Old Man
Item I have also Two thousand weight of Tob: also my whole Shop now going
on the land given him, also my Book of Stags, one Feather bed and Furniture
also all my Hens and Apes and also my two Horses to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Henry Turner my Negro Young Man
also one Feather bed and Furniture, also one Cest to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Turner my Negro Girl Sarah
also my Ready Money, also one Bed and Furniture, also one Cow and calf
to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my two Grandsons Turner Newsum and
James Newsum my Negro Girl Nancy.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Phebe Newsum the sum
of five Shillings.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Nathan Turner my Negro
Nason, Isaac, and Jude.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Henry Turner & Benjamin Turner, my Son
Potts Property to be equally divided between them.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Benjamin Turner One Guinea Cow

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Henry Turner and my Daughter Ann
Turner the Remainder of my Tobacco to be equally divided.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Benjamin Turner all my Cotton Also one
Oval Folding Table.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my sons Henry Turner & Benjamin Turner
the Remainder of my stock of Cattle, also my stock of the p, to be Equally divided.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Benjamin Turner the whole of my empty
Hog heads, and Barrels also my bed Room.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Turner all my Spanish
Item I give and Bequeath the Reversion of my Estate to my son Benjamin Turner
and do hereby appoint and authorize my son Nathan Turner and Henry Turner
my Executors to fulfil this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Twenty sixth day of May 1777
