Okefinger Road containing by estimation one hundred & thirty five Acres less the same more
or less, it being the whole of the land devised to me by my Father John Morgan, one Father
Sea and Trunkton, one Child, one Anne Saddle and all my part of the division of my Father's
Estate except what I may hereafter dispose of all which I give to her my said Sister to
her and her Heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved Brother in law Matthew Morgan one Cow
choicest out of what is allotted me out of Father's Estate to him & his Heirs forever.

Lastly, I do appoint my Friend Littlebury Mavor whole and sole Executor of my
last Will and Testament making and Confirming this and as that to be my last & full
& Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighth
day of May One thousand seven hundred and eighty one.
