I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Cupper one Featherbed of fine Vamp, I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Cupper one Featherbed of fine Vamp to her own choice and two large black bottles and one Copper Fire Stove and my smallest trumpet, and four Pewter Dishes and six Plates and six spoons and one Brass Wheel and one Cotton wheel and two pair Cotton Cards, and one Iron band of steel and all my wearing Cloth and all the open Yarn that shall be found in my possession at my Death and half my Ready Money and one large Bible and two Pewter basins and six Glass Bottles. To her and her heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my Grandson Henry Warren, Son of Michael Warren the other half of my Ready money mentioned, and two Cows and Calves and one Filly called Beg, and one Saddle and Bridle and one Buckner Gun

I give and bequeath to my Son Michael Warren all the rest of my Stock unmentioned and all the rest of my Estate that I have not before disposed of to him and his Heirs forever My Will and desire is that my Estate shall not be Appraised. And last I do Appoint my well beloved Friends Henry Bittle, and son Michael Warren my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and testament disannulling all other Wills and do declare this to be my only true Will.
