

Item, I give and bequeath to my Son Broomfield Ridley the following Negroes, to my  
Caro, Lucy, Saba, Sam, Nancy, Minny, Nutty, Betty, Shadrach, Cuff, Judy, & others  
and their increase to him and his heirs for ever. Also give to my Son Broomfield Ridley, my Negro, Shan  
his heirs for ever.

Item, I give and bequeath to Frances Ridley, wife of my Son Broomfield Ridley,  
and her heirs, my Dingy Chair, and its Harness, and my Chair house callie Rose.

Item, I give and bequeath to my Son William Ridley, the following Negroes and  
one, Dandy, Little Rose, Dicy, Aggab, Maggie, and Cato, and their increase, to  
him and his heirs for ever. Also divers unto my s<sup>r</sup>. Son William Ridley and  
his heirs for ever, all that Tract or parcel of Land, wherein I now liev Containing  
by estimation few hundred and twenty Acres, with the same mow or lea, lying  
on the north side of Ridgway Branch also one Bed and Furniture.

Item, I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Rebekah Ridley, Daughter of  
my Son Arthur Ridley, and her heirs for ever, my Negro man, Cesar, and my  
Negro Gil Lucy, who I sent to my son Arthur Ridley, but in case my Grand  
Daughter Rebekah Ridley, Daughter of Arthur Ridley aforesaid should  
die without issue him and in that case, I give and bequeath my said Negro  
Gil Lucy, to Rebekah Ridley, Daughter of James Day Ridley and her  
heirs for ever.

Item, I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Ridley, Daughter of James Day Ridley,  
and her heirs for ever, my Negro Woman, Callid, Clos, provided, that if the said  
Elizabeth Ridley Daughter of James Day Ridley should die without issue, then  
and in that case, I give and bequeath ther<sup>e</sup> Negro Woman, Clos, to Rebekah  
Ridley, Daughter of my son Arthur Ridley and to her heirs for ever.

Item, I devise to my grand son John Edwards Ridley, son of James Day Ridley and  
his heirs for ever, all that Tract or parcel of Land lying in the longround of McMur-  
Row which I purchas'd of John Edwards, and also one other Tract of Land wherein  
the said James Day Ridley died, which I purchas'd of Joseph Thorp.

Item, I give and bequeath to Broomfield Ridley and William Ridley my Sons,  
and to their heirs for ever, all the Residue, and every part and parcel of my estate of  
what kind soever not already Particular dispos'd of, to be equally divided between them.

Item, I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Ridley widow of Arthur Ridley dec'd, living Cope  
Bond which is for one hundred and fifty Pounds, John Francis Bond which  
is for one hundred and twenty five pounds and the ballance due from Master  
Francis Bond of Fifty Pounds, likewise a Ballance due from Miles Bay by Act<sup>d</sup>  
in my Books of Fifty one pounds ten Shillings. Recouered Bond, and Ballances &  
Money mentioned above, I give to ther<sup>e</sup> Elizabeth Ridley and her Daughter Rebekah  
to have & keep.

Item, I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Ridley Two Counter Pds  
Copper and White, which was worn at her House.

Lastly, I do Gonsestatis and appoint my Sons, Broomfield Ridley and William Ridley  
my sole Executore of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other  
Wills and Testaments by me hitherto made Certifying and Confirming this to be my last
