Now, I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Rebekah Ridley, Daughter of my Son, Arthur Ridley, and his heirs for ever, my Negro man, Oron, and my Negro Girl Lucy, who I lent to my son Arthur Ridley, but in case my Grand Daughter, Rebekah Ridley, Daughter of Arthur Ridley aforesaid should die without issue then and in that case, I give and bequeath my said Negro Girl Lucy, to Rebekah Ridley, Daughter of James Roy Ridley and his heirs for ever.
