In the Name of God Amens. I Benjamin Griffen of the County of Southampton being in per
fect health and sound of mind and memory do make this my last will and testament as follows
First I give and devise to my son James Griffen the following tract of land part of the lands I
now possess, supposed to contain fifty acres be the same more or less lying over the Dene Branch
joining Hardy Doyle's land John Christopher, to the Main Road by the Road to the cabin
Swamps of the Cabin Swamp to the said Dene Branch and up the branch to the said Doyle
land to him and his Heirs and assigns forever.
Also I give and devise to my Son Wiley Griffen fifty Acres of land that I purchased of William
Doyle, to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

Also I give and devise to my living wife Oliver the remaining parts of my lands that I now have or
supposed by me to contain one hundred Acres for the term only of her widowhood at the ex
piration of which Term I give and devise the said lands to be equally divided between my
two Sons Jack and Benjamin disregard in the division to be paid to the quality as well as
quantity I hold to my said Sons and to their heirs and assigns forever.

Also All the rest and remainder of my estate of what nature or kind so ever I hold the use of to
my said wife Oliver for the term of her widowhood for the purpose of her Support and the
Maintenance of my children who are underage. At the Marriage or death of my said wife
I direct that all the said residue and remainder of my estate be sold and that the money
arising by the sale of such estate be equally divided between all the children that may
survive me and their representatives. I do hereby constitute and ordain Benjamin Griffen
Executor of this my Will hereby revoking all others by me hitherto made. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty third day of March 1781.
