Iron pot to her and her Heirs for ever.

Item, I give unto my Grandson John Kendrick, one Saddle, and after my just debts are paid,
I give him all the remainder of my Estate both Real and personal to him and his heirs forever,
I wish that my Estate may not be appraised. I do appoint my Grandson John Kendrick,
Executor of this my last will and Testament (revoking all others by me heretofore
made, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and affixed my seal
this nineteenth day of Nov: one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine.
