

353. I do appoint my Uncle George Gunley sole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, & I witness to the same, & have thereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of March 1781. Signed George Gunley, publisher of & declare by him said Will Edward Gunley, his husband Will and Testament in the presence of George Edward Gunley, Thomas ^{his} Edwards, William Edwards Esq.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 13th day of Oct 1758. This Will
was presented in Court by George Huntly the Executor thereto named and proved by the
natives of George Edwards and George Huntly son of the Testator deceased and admitted to
be executed. And on the motion of the 3rd Decr who makes oath according to law
certified it granteth him for obtaining a Probate in law from giving Security
