being of sound and disposing mind ~~and~~ do make this Writing for my last

Will and Testament,

First I Give to my Son James Hall the sum of Five thousand pounds, being the
Money which he owes me for a story written named Guy, also one desk with all things
my best bed and furniture having a blue Rug, one oval Table of black Walnut and
small looking glass one hand butter fat, and one stone Jug. One pair of silver buckles
one buckle and one buckle also all my wearing clothes also two Head of cattle
One cow of white and brown light feet:

Also I Give to my Daughter Ann Woods my Negro Woman named Grand also my best
best of Fether bed and furniture with a Green Rug one silver painted gown and a large
looking glass, also my cushion and stone earthen and glass one stone jug and stone fat
Also four Head of Cattle one blue pig one and a bone lantern with the pipe belonging
to our oven one black ewe and Lamb which I purchased of the Widow Lane.

Also I Give and devise to my Son George Hall my negro Girl named Betty also all the
debt that is due to me from the said George Hall, and bed and furniture with a
fether bed also two Head of Cattle one large stone fat one ^{best} stone jug one large fish

Also I Give and devise to my Son James Hall above mentioned one small iron pot &
fish tongs and each a popper of Miniver and fether my shute and buckle also one fishing
bar and two tongs.

Also I Give to my Wife all the estate that formerly belonged to Joseph Esqr. that is
in his profession during her Natural life, also I Give her all my stocks of Money
during the said term of life. Likewise three Acres and the Remainder of my Shop
during her life, I Give her my feeding horses paying of her shoe footers at her own
charge I Give the estate I Give her to her Son Obadiah Esqr.

Also All the book I have I Give to Equally divided between my three Children
James Hall, George Hall, and Ann Woods Likewise my paper Money by Count
And all the rest residue and remainder part of my estate of what nature a kind comes
I Give and Equally to be equally divided between my said three Children James Hall
George Hall and Ann Woods.

I Give to my Son my Wife Elizabeth Hall severally to have this my last will
provis on Count I Give the estate I Give her her son into my three estates also I Give
my estate not to be appraised. Likewise I Give and appoint my Son James Hall of
George Hall executor of this my last will and testament receiving all other debts my
last debts made and Whose I have herewith set my hand and a Press my seal on the
day of February 1781 signed sealed and published and declared as the last will and Testa-
ment of the Testator in the presence of us.
