Will

being of sound mind and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner following (to wit) after my just debts and Funeral expences are defrayed I dispose of my property as followeth.

First I give and bequeath to my beloved wife all that Tract or parcel of Land wherein I now live containing by estimation two hundred and eighty eight Acres be the same more or less during her natural life. I also give to my said wife all my stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep and Hogs; also my Household Furniture to her and her Heirs forever.

Item I devise unto Miles Jeynes, son of Amos Jeynes, and his Heirs forever all that Tract of Land wherein I now live containing by estimation Two hundred and eighty eight Acres be same more or less, after my wife's death.

Item I do constitute and appoint my Friends Jacob Burn whole and sole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 27th day of September 1781
