Item I give and bequeath unto my son Jesse Gardner one Negro boy named Pompey One gray
 horse and thirty pounds Cash unto Wm and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lydia Garner five Shillings unto her and her
 heirs forever

Item I lend unto my beloved Wife Ann Gardner all the Remainder part of my whole
 Estate during her Life or Widowhood to raise and bring up the Children upon

Item I give unto Daughter Milly Gardner 1 Negro Boy named Charles unto her and her heirs
 forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Gardner one hundred acres of Land bought of
 Wm Neal lying the south side of the parish of Nettoway and one Negro Girl named Liz
 unto him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Gardner one Negro Girl named Sylvia
 unto her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Gardner one Negro man named Jupiter unto
 him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Gardner one Negro woman named
 Pree unto her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto Phely Gardner one Negro woman named Jude unto her
 and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Amos Gardner my manner Plantation unto him
 and his heirs forever

Item And after the decease or Marriage of my beloved Wife Ann Gardner the remainder
 part of the whole Estate is to be equally divided between the Children as namely Jesse
 Garner, Milly Garner, John Garner, Ann Garner, Mary Garner, Phely
 Garner, James Garner, Amos Garner, unto them and their heirs forever

Item I do appoint my sons Jesse Gardner John Garner my whole &
 sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament Reserving unto
 me and my heirs all other writings or writings Will or debts claims or demands
 to Whereunto I have affixed my seal and subscribed my name
