I Item I give unto my Peppley Barret the Plantation now live on also One negro woman and one negro boy Any one negro girl Lucy or Negro man Cornelius one negro man having two of the best feather beds I give them two Cows & Calfs two years and Lambs two years & Pigs one sow & two Barrels and Saddle one Gun and French and looking Glass and Pot and dishes Plates and all the Iron works belonging to the Plantation for the use of the plantation And one negro Boy Solomon Hammon

Yoke of young steers & Wheels for the use of the plantation till my son Peppley Barret comes to the age of eighteen years to him and his lawful begetting of his body forever

I appoint my son Hancock Barret as Trustee to live on the plantation that I have left to my son Peppley Barret and for him to have all the profit that he can make only he is to take good care of the said plantation and all that is left upon it and to improve to the best of my knowledge as much as possible till my son Peppley Barret arrives to the age of eighteen years of the date thinks proper by his behaviour then for him to have his estate if not for him to continue until he arrives to the age of twenty one years of age unless he should marry

I Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy his Negro Woman Cook

I Item I give and bequeath to my son Willm Barret one Negro Girl Dolly

I Item I give and bequeath to my son Charles Barret one Negro Girl Dolly and one Cook

I Item I give to my son Peppley Barret one Negro Boy named Tom

I Item I give and bequeath to my son Hancock Barret one Negro man named Tom and all my Negro Cash
