and Order this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first
I recommend my soul to the Almighty God &c. I Give unto my loving Mother during her
life a negro boy Arden and then to my Sister Patsy and if she die without him to my
brother John Cleveland and all my personal Estate to be sold to pay my debts there remain due
after debts to fall to my brother John Cleveland. I Give after my mothers death a negro
Girl named Lena unto my brother John. Also give unto my brother John Cleveland all negro
women named Ann and if he die without him all that I have left him to go to my
sister Patsy to her and her heirs forever. I do make this my last will and testament
revoking all other wills heretofore made by me and I do appoint my friends John
Andrews and Stephen Samonuels my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will
and Testament Giving Under this the 16 day of December 1775
