

At a Court held at the County of Southampton the 13th day of June 1782. This Account of the
Estate of Francis Turner late was this day returned and Ordered to be Printed
In the name of the First Person etc.

In the Name of God Amen I Christopher Wade of Southampton County one
of the Parish of Northway being sick and weak of body but of sound Mind and Memory
and of a disposing mind calling to mind the uncertainty of this Travelling by land
knowing that it is dangerous for all men to die so think fit to make this my last
will and testament in manner and form following to wit

I now give and bequeath to my son Wilson Wade the land and Plantation whereon
and his family now dwelleth being One hundred Acres to him and his heirs
Wilson Stand unto my friend Sarah Turner securing Natural life thereon after the Plantation
whereon I now Dwelleth being the land as Strugles of Land and City like Waterbury
then I give unto my friend Sarah Turner five shillings for the use of my cattle One 3 Shillings and
Upon Shores East Side and furniture One large Iron Bed two Pewter Pans and one
Chant One Dozen small Pewter Boxes and one Plate

I now give unto my Grand son John Wade the land and Plantation after the death
of Sarah Turner which I have left to her and the late George as I have little here and
in case my Grand son John Wade die before he arrives to the Age of twenty one years having
no share of his body buried by lightness then I give the said land to my Grand son
Samuel Wade to him and his heirs

Given it to my wife and desire that all the rest of my estate not already mentioned be
Equally divided among my wife Anna Conant Wade my son Nelson Wade my daughter
Sarah Wade and my daughter Martha Wade to have & their heirs
In the 1^o day of October A.D. 1888.
