In the Name of God. Amen I Perfecta Blunt of the Parish of St. Luke in the County of Southampton of sound mind and Memory do make this my last will and Testament in manner and form as followeth. I Give and bequeath to my son John Blunt and to his heirs forever all that tract or parcel of land Situate of Calcutta and Water containing Two hundred Acres be the same more or less Also I give to my said John and to his heirs my Negro woman Rachel and her and their future issue Likewise I give to David Stephen Jory Arthur Wadley also the Reversion of my whole Estate that is not hereafter Mentioned.

I Give to my Grand son James Turner son of Jacob my Negro boy David if my aforesaid Grand son die without heir of his body lawfully begotten then I Give the said Negro boy David to my Grand son John Blunt son of John.

I Give and bequeath to my son William Blunt Two Shillings Current Money and that to be his part of my Estate.

I Give and bequeath to my daughter Perfecta Turner Fifty pounds Sterling wearing clothes and Riding Saddle.

I Give my Grand son Edmund Turner one feather Bed & Turnsole.

I Give my Grand daughter Martha Turner Ten pounds.

I Give to my Grand daughter Temperance Turner Ten pounds.

I Give to my Grand daughter Elizabeth Turner Ten pounds.

And I do constitute and appoint my son John Blunt my whole and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25 day of February 1789.
