One thousand seven hundred & eighty nine. I William Williams being sick in body

for all men once to die, do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament in
manner & form following. First of all I give my Soul to the almighty God gave it me, &
my body I leave to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named & what
worldly goods it hath pleased God to bless me with I desire of them as followeth: To wit
I give & bequeath unto my wife Sarah Williams during of her life or widows need &
after her death or widowhood I give unto my Son Jacob Williams & his heirs forever
