Beginning at the head of Blunts swamp on Barrows Road, thence down the Road to Thomas Swamp up the said swamp to a Joshua tree, thence along a line of marked trees to the head of the long prong of Blunts swamp down the said swamp to my line, along this line to another prong of Blunts swamp up this prong to the beginning.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Hemen Williams & his heirs for ever all my land on the East side of Isaac Popes path, also my Gun.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Elisha Williams & his heirs for ever all the remaining part of my land on the south side of the long prong of Blunts Swamp. I also give unto my son Elisha Williams all my carpenters & joiners tools to him & his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rhoda Williams & her heirs for ever One feather bed & furniture, also 2 Spenser dishes, & four plates all the remaining part of my household & kitchen furniture I give unto my wife Sarah Williams & her heirs for ever, also I give unto my said wife all my Hogs & Cows.

My will and desire is that all the remaining part of my Estate be sold by my Executors & the money to be equally divided between my children, Elisha, Hemen, Jacob, & Rhoda, Williams, & their heirs for ever. My will and desire is that if either of my sons die under the age of twenty one years, that survivor or survivors have the lands equally divided betwixt them & their heirs for ever.

I do constitute & appoint my friends Samuel Edmunds, & Thomas Vaughans whole & sole Executors of this my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written.
