 all my cattle that I am possessed with at the time of my death, likewise my Mare, Bridle,
 and saddle, all my sheep, all my hogs, all my Pater two peach coals, two irons & heaters
 two wedges, two mowing hoes, two grubbing hoes and all the rest of my Tools, two Mugs
 two chests, one bee hive, and all the rest of my Estate that I am possessed with at the time
 of my death, only he the said Haley shall pay my just debts, and I do hereby appoint my
 son Haley Foster and Richard Foster my Executors of this my last will and testament
 as witness my hand & seal this 24th day of July in the Year of our Lord 1776

I give to my Sister Anne Bailey my land and Negro called Mingo and all the
 residue of my Estate, be it in any kind or quality whatsoever to her and her heirs
 forever.
 I do appoint Jacob Bailey my whole & sole Executor to this my last will & Testament
 revoking all other wills by me before made as Witness my hand and seal this
 eleventh day of April, and in the year of our Lord Christ, one thousand seven hundred
 and eighty one.
