In the name of God. Amen. This 27th day of December 1782 I John M^r Lemore of Southampton County being sick & weak in body but of sound & disposing mind & memory do make & ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form following first & foremost I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it in hope of a joyfull resurrection of the same. And as for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I dispose of as follows. (To wit) I give to my Sons John & Joel M^r Lemore all my land to be equally divided between them, the division to be made by my Executors hereafter to be mentioned together with whosoever they shall think proper to appoint, & in case either of my above mentioned sons shall die without lawfull issue or dispose of their part of said Land, then I give the whole of said land to the other Son above mentioned, to him and his heirs for ever, but in case both of my said sons should die without lawfull issue or make sale of said land then I give my said Land to my Daughters Elisabeth, Olive & M^r herina M^r Lemore to be sold & the money equally divided between them, to them and their heirs for ever. Item I give to my Son James M^r Lemore one bed & furniture, some powder which he has already in possession, also all the money that he owes me except four pounds piece that he is to pay to George Bay. Item I give to my Daughter Martha Morgan & Mary Norvell to each of them ten Shillings. Item I give to my Daughter Priscilla M^r Lemore one bed & furniture which she has in possession, and after her decease to her daughter Elizth M^r Lemore to her heirs for ever. Item I leave all the rest of my Estate after my just Debts being paid to be equally divided between my wife Elizth M^r Lemore & three Daughters Elisabeth, Olive & M^r herina M^r Lemore to them and their heirs for ever. I do hereby appoint John Rogers & Tho^s Turner Executors of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & Year first above written.
