from After the death of my loving wife aforesaid I desire that all the personal estate I have, or what she may leave of it be sold and the money arising from such sale to be equally divided amongst all my children then living.
from I desire my Estate be not appraised. I also empower my son John to make a deed to WM Ely for a hundred acres land I sold him
from And Lastly I do nominate and appoint my loving wife executrix and my loving sons John & Arthur Applewhite Co's to this my last will and testament hereby making null and void all former wills and bequests heretofore by me made and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of May 1783.
