I give the use of the land and plantation wherein I now dwell with the appurtenances to my loving wife Mary Williford during her natural life the use of all the remaining part of my Estate of every kind for the maintenance & support of herself and Children, provided nevertheless that if my said wife should marry, that then there should be an equal Division made of all the personal Estate which I have given her my said wife the use of betwixt her and all my children hereafter named, in case of her not marrying that at her death an equal division of what Estate may be then remaining, may be made between all my children as aforesaid or in case of Death of any of them, the survivors of them
