

One whipsaw, one tenant saw, a set of shoemakers tools, One Gun and half  
of my carpenters, coopers & Turners tool to him and his heirs for ever.  
Whereas my wife Sarah Washington is now with child, if she should be de-  
livered of a son that doth live, I give and devise unto him as follows, the  
remainder part of my land lying on the south side of the river Branch  
containing one hundred and sixty acres, more or less, and three hundred  
pounds current money of Virginia, one large church bible, one cross cut saw  
one Gun, and the other half of my carpenters, coopers and turners tools,  
and one feather bed and furniture, or the Value in money at her coming  
of age to him and his heirs for ever.

Fourthly

If my wife should be delivered of a Daughter, I give and devise unto her  
the following articles. Five hundred pounds current money of Virginia, and  
one feather bed and furniture, or the Value in money.

My will and desire is that my Executors do sell my Negro Ben, and  
all the remainder of my Estate of what nature or kind soever, that has  
not been given in Legacies, and after paying my just debts and legacies  
the remainder to be equally divided between my children then living.  
Likewise my will and desire is that after the death of my wife, my  
Executors do equally divide the Estate that I have left to her use, bet-  
ween my aforesaid children. I likewise constitute and appoint Henry  
Briggs and my wife Sarah Washington Executor and Executrix of this  
my last will and testament. Given under my hand and Seal this  
fifth day of November, one thousand seven hundred and eighty
