Item I give to my loving wife Mary Bailey the use of the plantation whoms house live containning three hundred and ten acres also the use of my Collier Hall during her life and after her death to be disposed off as hereafter mentioned. I also give unto my loving wife Mary Bailey the following Negroes Peter, Tom, Fanny, Judy, Regis, Daniel Davis & Maria to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give to my Son James Bailey two Negroes, Ben & Mourning to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give to my daughter Calia Barlow one Negro man Sam to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give to my daughter Martha Booth one Negro girl Tubb & Five pounds to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give to my daughter Elisabeth Hayes one Negro Boy Charles and Five pounds to her & her heirs for ever.

Item I give to my Son Richard Bailey my lands in Sussex county containning three hundred & sixty four acres and three Negroes Frank, Kate & Peg to him & his heirs for ever.

Item I give to my Daughter Lucy Colthorpe the use of my Negro girl Meliora during her life, and at her death to my grand daughter Mary Bailey Colthorpe. I also give to my said daughter Lucy Colthorpe one negro man Sam, to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give to my Grand daughter Lucy Bailey one Negro girl Maria to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give to my Grand daughter Mary Bailey Colthorpe one Negro Boy Jimmy Fisher & her heirs for ever.

It is my will and desire that my Negro Girl Fanny be sold and the money arising from the sale of her be one half paid my daughter Calia Barlow, and the other half be equally divided between my Grandchildren the Children of my Daughter - Ann Coker. It is also my Will and desire that after the death of my wife the lands left her, be sold and the money arising from the Sale be equally divided between my Sons James Bailey, Richard Bailey and my daughter Lucy Colthorpe and the Hall (the use of which is left to my wife during her life & shall at her death) be given to my Son Richard Bailey. The residue & remainder of my Estate of what nature or kind soever (after paying my just debts and legacies) I give to my loving wife Mary Bailey & her heirs for ever.
