I Henry Vaughan being sick & weak in body but of sound mind and memory thanks be to God for the same and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this to be my last will & testament in manner & form following. First I give my soul to the almighty that gave it me & my body I leave to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named. & touching what worldly good I have I dispose off as follows.

I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Vaughan & his heirs forever one Negro fellow named Tom.

I give and bequeath unto my son Howell Vaughan & his heirs forever the plantation wherein I now live, and all the lands belonging to the said plantation that I am now possessed off. also one negro named Simon, One horse called Damons, one iron pot, four pewter plates & two chairs.

My will & desire is that all the remaining part of my Estate be sold and after paying my Debts that the money be equally divided between my sons Thomas Vaughan & Howell Vaughan & their heirs for ever I do constitute & appoint my sons Thomas Vaughan & Howell
